# <u>Findings and Decision - Renewal Application of Vince Stuart for AQ#0828</u>

### 1. Overview

On March 5, 2019, the Nova Scotia Department of Fisheries and Aquaculture received an assignment application from 3318168 Nova Scotia Limited for Aquaculture Licence and Lease #0828, as described below:

### 2. History

AQ#0828 was first issued on May 24, 1996 for a ten-year term (May 24, 2996 to May 24, 2006) for the suspended cultivation of Giant sea scallops and Soft shell clams (one-year experimental). AQ#0828 was amended on September 28, 1998 to extend the term of experimental Soft shell clam cultivation and to authorize the cultivation of European oysters. AQ#0828 was amended on October 12, 2000 to authorize the cultivation of Blue mussels and Soft shell clams, and the suspended cultivation of Bay quahogs. AQ#0828 was renewed on June 6, 2007 for a five-year term (May 24, 2006 to May 23, 2011). AQ#0828 was renewed on April 11, 2012 for a five-year term (May 24, 2011 to May 23, 2016). AQ#0828 was renewed on October 25, 2016 for a ten-year licence term (May 24, 2016 to May 24, 2026) and a twenty-year lease term (May 24, 2016 to May 24, 2036).

### 3. Procedure

### 3.1 Performance Review

Despite multiple requests by the NSDFA to the assignee, Due to a lack of application information submitted by the assignee, the application did not progress to the stage of having a performance review completed.

#### 3.2 Public Comment Period

Notice of application for the assignment of AQ#0828 for the 30-day public comment period was published on NSDFA's website (<a href="http://novascotia.ca/fish/aquaculture/public-information">http://novascotia.ca/fish/aquaculture/public-information</a>) for the period of June 6, 2019to July 5, 2019. Notice of the applicant was also published in the Royal Gazette Part I on June 12, June 19, June 26 and July 3 2019.

#### 3.3 Submissions

Zero submissions were received by NSDFA during the 30-day public comment period.

## 4. Factors to be considered

Despite several attempts by the NSDFA to contact the assignee, insufficient detail was provided in the assignment application to allow for consideration of the relevant regulatory factors.

## 5. Decision

Due to a lack of application information submitted by the applicant, the assignment application for AQ#0828 was rejected on May 7, 2020.
