NOVA SCOTIA PROVINCIAL PHARMACARE PROGRAMS Statement of Returned Benefits

Pharmacare benefits dispensed to a beneficiary in a facility licensed pursuant to the *Homes for Special Care Act* can be returned to stock where, in the exercise of professional judgement, the pharmacist deems it appropriate to do so and where all of the conditions in the Nova Scotia College of Pharmacists' "Return of Medication" policy are met:

- The beneficiary has not been in possession of the benefit.
- The lot numbers and expiry dates (where applicable) of the benefit are directly attached to the dispensed container.
- Each dose of the drug/product is individually sealed and the seal is intact at the time of the return to the pharmacy.
- The pharmacist has sufficient knowledge of the medication administration and storage conditions/policies of the facility registered under the Homes for Special Care Act to permit the exercise of professional judgment.
