

## POLICE GOVERNANCE STANDARDS PROVINCE OF NOVA SCOTIA

## 001.00 POLICE ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 001.01 Approved: April 17, 2007
- 001.02 The Nova Scotia *Police Act* mandates the Minister of Justice to ensure that an adequate and effective level of policing is maintained throughout the Province of Nova Scotia.
- 001.03 Police agencies in Nova Scotia, as part of the justice system, and in accordance with the *Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms*, are responsible for maintaining peace and order, protecting lives and property, preventing and investigating crime, and providing policing services that are responsive to community needs.
- 001.04 The Minister of Justice may issue a directive or a Governance Standard to a police agency, and may require a police agency to develop a directive or a standard operating or administrative procedure.
- 001.05 Operational or administrative policy and procedure approved by the police agency is to include and demonstrate:
  - (a) the agency has a written directives system including department policies
  - (b) procedures for indexing, purging, updating and revision of directives and policies
  - (c) identification of personnel, other than the agencies Chief of Police, authorized to issue written directives
  - (d) procedures for a formal system to ensure the distribution of directives to appropriate personnel
