

**IN THE MATTER OF the NOVA SCOTIA REVIEW BOARD**

**AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, JOHN THOMAS ANDREWS**

**AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.81 (1) and (2.1) of the Criminal Code**

**DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2006, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on two charges of attempted murder, contrary to section 239 of the Criminal Code, one charge of assault with a weapon, contrary to section 267(a) of the Criminal Code, and one charge of uttering threats, contrary to section 264.1 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is currently detained in hospital;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2018, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 and 672.81(2.1) of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** the conditional discharge previously granted be continued, on the following terms:


1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
2. Maintain good mental health;
3. Adhere to the recommendations of the Community Mental Health Team;
4. Comply with follow up by the Forensic Community Program;
5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;
6. Abstain from the use of alcohol, mood altering substances and illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;
7. Reside in premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide by the rules and regulations of the residence;
8. Notify the Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change of address;
9. Appear before the Board when requested;
10. Remain within the province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing has been

received from the Board.

The Board finds that the hospital was justified in restricting the liberties of the accused.

**THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU**, the Administrator of the East Coast Forensic Hospital, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to him the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
