DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 8th day of June, 2006, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on two charges of attempted murder, contrary to section 239 of the Criminal Code, one charge of assault with a weapon, contrary to section 267(a) of the Criminal Code, and one charge of uttering threats, contrary to section 264.1 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained in hospital, although previously granted a conditional discharge;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 8th day of June, 2015, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the conditional discharge previously granted to the accused be revoked and he be detained in hospital with a ceiling of privileges of L6.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Administrator of the East Coast Forensic Hospital, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to him the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1). **DATED** at Truro, Nova Scotia, this 19th day of July, 2015.
