DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 19th day of November, 2003, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on three charges of assault, contrary to section 266 of the Criminal Code, two charges of mischief, contrary to section 430(4) of the Criminal Code, two charges of uttering threats, contrary to section 264.1 of the Criminal Code, and taking a motor vehicle, contrary to section 335 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently detained in hospital, having been placed here after a dual status offender hearing with a current ceiling of privileges of L2;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 25th day of August, 2014, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.81(2.1) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused young person, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made.

IT IS ORDERED that the accused continue to be detained in hospital with a ceiling of privileges of L2.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Services, Capital District Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this order. The Board delegates to him the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
