DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on June 28, 2016, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on charges of assault, contrary to section 266 of the Criminal Code; resisting a peace officer, contrary to section 192(a) of the Criminal Code; and assaulting a peace officer, contrary to section 270(1)(a) of the Criminal Code; and furthermore, on September 23, 2016, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of assault causing bodily harm, contrary to section 267(b) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital;
AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 2nd day of
October, 2017, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;
AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or
assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment, placement order or disposition is
made:

IT IS ORDERED that the accused be conditionally discharged, on the following terms:

- 1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
- 2. Maintain good mental health;
- 3. Adhere to the recommendations of the community mental health team;
- 4. Comply with follow up by the forensic community program;
- 5. Comply with conditions recommended by the forensic community program;
- 6. Abstain from the use of alcohol and illegal drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;
- 7. Notify the Board and the hospital of any change in address;
- 8. Appear before the Board when requested;
- 9. Remain within the province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing from the

Board has been obtained;

10. Reside in premises approved by the hospital.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Services, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to him pursuant to section 672.56(1) the authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberties of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits set out in this disposition.
