

**IN THE MATTER OF the NOVA SCOTIA REVIEW BOARD

Hearing) of the Criminal Code**

### **DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of April, 2021, the accused was found Not Criminally Responsible on account of a mental disorder on charges of: mischief, contrary to s.430(4) of the Criminal Code x3; assault, contrary to s.266 of the Criminal Code x3; robbery, contrary to s.344 of the Criminal Code x2; assault with a weapon, contrary to s.267(a) of the Criminal Code x2; possession of a weapon for dangerous purpose, contrary to s.88 (1) of the Criminal Code; at large on a Release Order and fails to attend, contrary to s.145(2)(A) of the Criminal Code; having appeared, fails to subsequently attend court as directed, contrary to s.145(2)(B) of the Criminal Code; causing a disturbance by fighting, screaming, shouting, swearing, singing, or using insults or obscene language, contrary to s.175(1)(A) of the Criminal Code; uttering threats to cause death or bodily harm, contrary to s.264.1(1)(A) of the Criminal Code x3; resists/obstructs Peace Officer, contrary to s.129(A) of the Criminal Code; and assaulting a Peace Officer, contrary to s.270(1)(A) of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of June 2021 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** the accused be detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital with a ceiling level of privileges of L6;

**THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU**, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
