

**IN THE MATTER OF the NOVA SCOTIA REVIEW BOARD**

**AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, ANDREW WILSON BALL**

**AND IN THE MATTER OF** a hearing held pursuant to section 672.81(1) and (2.1) of the Criminal Code

**DISPOSITION ORDER (Amended December 10, 2022)**

**WHEREAS** on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December 2019, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on charges of assault with a weapon, contrary to section 267(a) of the Criminal Code and uttering threats, contrary to section 264.1(1)(a) of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is currently residing in the community on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held on the 12th day of July 2022 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** the accused continue to be conditionally discharged, on the following terms:


1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
1. Maintain good mental health;
2. Adhere to the recommendations of the Community Mental Health Team;
3. Comply with follow-up by the Forensic Community Program;
4. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;

5. Abstain from alcohol, cannabis and/or illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;
6. Reside in the premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide by the rules and regulations of the residence;
7. Notify the Review Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change of address;
8. Appear before the Board when requested;
9. Remain within the Province of Nova Scotia; and
10. No weapons as defined in the Criminal Code.

**The Board also finds that the restriction of liberties was justified.**

**AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that if the accused is arrested pursuant to section 672.91 of the Criminal Code for a breach or anticipated breach of the terms of this disposition, they may, under section 672.92(1)(b) of the Criminal Code, be delivered to the East Coast Forensic Hospital, 88 Gloria McCluskey Avenue, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia.
