

IN THE MATTER OF the NOVA SCOTIA REVIEW BOARD

AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, NEIL ROBERT BURNS

AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.81(1) of the Criminal Code

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 1st day of October 2018 the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on two charges of assault, contrary to section 266 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is residing in the hospital on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 11th day of January 2022 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused continue to be conditionally discharged, on the following terms:

1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
2. Maintain good mental health;
3. Adhere to the recommendations of the Community Mental Health Team;
4. Comply with follow-up by the Forensic Community Program;
5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;
6. Abstain from alcohol, cannabis and/or illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;
7. Reside in the premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide by

- the rules and regulations of the residence;
8. Notify the Review Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change of address;
 9. Appear before the Board when requested; and
 10. Remain within the Province of Nova Scotia;
