

**IN THE MATTER OF** the NOVA SCOTIA REVIEW BOARD  
**AND IN THE MATTER OF** the accused, PAUL NORMAN CLUNEY  
**AND IN THE MATTER OF** a hearing held pursuant to section 672.81(1) of the  
*Criminal Code of Canada.*

**DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1984, the accused was found not guilty by reason of insanity on a charge of indecent assault;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is currently residing at King's Rehab under the terms of a conditional discharge;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on April 11th, 2017, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment, disposition or placement decision is made.

**IT IS ORDERED** that the conditional discharge previously granted to the accused be continued, upon the following terms:

1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
2. Maintain good mental health;
3. Adhere to the recommendations of the community mental health team;
4. Comply with follow up by the Forensic Community Program;
5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;
6. Abstain from the use of alcohol and illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;
7. Reside in premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide by the rules and regulations of the residence;
8. Notify the Board and the hospital of any change of address;
9. Appear before the Board when requested;

10. Remain within the province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing has been received from the Board;
11. Do not associate with children under the age of 14 unsupervised.

**THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU**, the Director, Mental Health Services, Capital District Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to the Director the authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberty of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits of this disposition pursuant to section 672.56(1).
