DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 19th day of May, 2011, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on charges of assault, contrary to section 266 of the Criminal Code, mischief, contrary to section 430(4) of the Criminal Code, and breach of probation, contrary to section 733.1 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 2nd day of

June, 2014, to make an order pursuant to section 672.81(2.1) and 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody,

treatment or assessment of the accused in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or

placement decision is made;

The Board orders the continued detention of Mr. DeCoste at the East Coast Forensic Hospital with a ceiling of privileges of up to six overnight indirectly supervised passes per week.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Services, Capital District Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this order. The Board delegates to the Director the authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberty of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits of this disposition pursuant to section 672.56(1).
