AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.81 (2.1) (Restriction of Liberties) and 678.81 (1) (Annual Hearing) of the Criminal Code

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on 22nd of November 2018, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on two charges of assault, contrary to Section 266 of the Criminal Code, a charge of mischief, contrary to Section 430(4) of the Criminal Code and a charge of resisting arrest/obstructing a peace officer contrary to Section 129(a) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital with a ceiling level of privileges of L3;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 13th day of December 2021 and the 24th day of January 2022 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;


AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the hospital was justified in restricting the accused's liberties.

IT IS ALSO ORDERED THAT the accused continue to be detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital with a ceiling level of privileges of L3;

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
