## **DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of July 2022, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of a mental disorder on charges of possession of weapon for a dangerous purpose contrary to s.88(1) of the Criminal Code and a charge of carrying a concealed weapon contrary to s.90(1) of the *Criminal Code of Canada*;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is currently residing in the community;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of October 2022 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** the accused be conditionally discharged, on the following terms:

- 1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
- 2. Maintain good mental health;
- 3. Adhere to the recommendations of the Community Mental Health Team;
- 4. Comply with follow-up by the Forensic Community Program;
- 5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;
- 6. Abstain from alcohol, and/or illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;

- 7. Reside in the premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide by the rules and regulations of the residence;
- 8. Notify the Review Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change of address;
- 9. Appear before the Board when requested; and
- 10. Remain within the Province of Nova Scotia unless required to travel to New Brunswick for his outstanding criminal matter.

**THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU**, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
