AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.81 (1) and (2.1) of the Criminal Code of Canada

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 17th day of December, 2015, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on charges of theft under \$5,000, contrary to section 334(b) of the Criminal Code, occurring on September 1, 2015, in Kennetcook; theft of a motor vehicle, contrary to section 333.1 of the Criminal Code, occurring on September 9th in Kennetcook; mischief, contrary to section 430(4) of the Criminal Code, occurring on September 16 in Dartmouth; theft of a motor vehicle contrary to section 333.1 of the Criminal Code, occurring on September 19 – 21 in Upper Kennetcook (two counts); theft of a motor vehicle, contrary to section 333.2 of the Criminal Code and failure to comply with an undertaking, contrary to section 145(3) of the Criminal Code, both occurring on October 1, 2015, in Upper Kennetcook; and mischief, contrary to section 430(4) of the Criminal Code, occurring on October 8, 2015, in Dartmouth;

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently detained in hospital although previously granted a conditional discharge;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 24th day of January, 2017, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.81(1) and (2.1) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED that the conditional discharge previously granted be continued, on the following terms:

1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
2. Maintain good mental health;

3. Adhere to the recommendations of the Community Mental Health Team;
4. Comply with follow up by the Forensic Community Program;
5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;
6. Abstain from the use of alcohol and illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;
7. Reside in premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide by the rules and regulations of the residence;
8. Notify the Review Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change of address;
9. Appear before the Board when requested;
10. Remain within the province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing has been received from the Board.
11. Do not initiate contact with Nadia Dajani.

The Board finds that the hospital was justified in restricting the liberties of the accused.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Services, Capital District Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to him pursuant to section 672.56(1) the authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberties of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits set out in this disposition.
