Disposition Order

Whereas on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of July, 2020, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of a mental disorder on charges of: theft under, contrary to section 334(b) of the Criminal Code; on a charge of possession under, contrary to section 355(b) of the Criminal Code; on a charge of mischief, contrary to section 430(4) of the Criminal Code; on a charge of assault with a weapon, contrary to section 267(a) of the Criminal Code ;and on a charge of assault, contrary to section 266 of the Criminal Code of Canada.

And whereas the accused is presently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital;

And whereas a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital by Zoom conference on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2020, to make a disposition order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code of Canada;

And whereas the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made.

**It is ordered that** the accused continue to be detained in the East Coast Forensic Hospital with L5 privileges.

**This is therefore to command you**, the administrator of the East Coast Forensic Hospital, in her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this order. The Board delegates to the administrator, pursuant to section 672.56(1), the authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberties of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits set out in this disposition.
