## AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, JOSHUA HAGEN

AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held under section 672.81(2.1) of the Criminal Code

## DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 15<sup>th</sup> of June, 2017, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of uttering threats, contrary to section 264.1 of the Criminal Code; a charge of assault, contrary to section 266 of the Criminal Code; and a further charge of uttering threats, contrary to section 264.1 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is currently detained in hospital, having been readmitted after living in the community under the terms of a conditional discharge;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2017, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.81(2.1) of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED** that the conditional discharge previously granted be continued, on the following terms:

- 1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
- 2. Maintain good mental health;
- 3. Adhere to the recommendations of the community mental health team;
- 4. Comply with follow up by the forensic community program;
- 5. Comply with conditions recommended by the forensic community program;
- 6. Abstain from the use of alcohol and illegal drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;
- 7. Notify the Board and the hospital of any change in address;
- 8. Appear before the Board when requested;
- 9. Remain within the province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing from the Board has been obtained;
- 10. Reside in premises approved by the hospital.

## The Board finds that the hospital was justified in restricting the liberties of the accused.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Services, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to him pursuant to section 672.56(1) the authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberties of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits set out in this disposition.
