AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.81(1) of the *Criminal Code*

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 28th day of October, 2021, the accused was found *Unfit to Stand Trial* on account of mental disorder on a charge of Assault contrary to s.266 of the *Criminal Code* of Canada

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently detained at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 6th day of December, 2022 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to s.672.54 of the *Criminal Code of Canada*

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made.

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused continue to be detained in the East Coast Forensic Hospital with a community access level of L5. The Boards finds the accused remains unfit to stand trial.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
