AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.82(1) (Discretionary Hearing) and section 672.81(2.1) (Restriction of Liberties) of the Criminal Code

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 27th day of January 2016, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on charges of assault with a weapon, contrary to section 267(A) of the Criminal Code and a breach of probation contrary to section 733.1 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently residing in the East Coast Forensic Hospital on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 14th day of September 2021 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be detained with a ceiling level of privileges of L4;

The Board also finds that the hospital was justified in restricting the liberties of Mr. Issak.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
