## DISPOSITION ORDER

**WHEREAS** on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2012, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on two charges of committing an indecent act, contrary to section 173(1)(a) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently detained in hospital

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of May, 2016, to make an order pursuant to section 672.81(2.1) of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition order or placement decision is made.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** the accused continue to be detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital with a ceiling of privileges of L4.

The Board finds that the hospital was justified in restricting the liberties of the accused.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Capital District Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to him authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberty of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits set out herein pursuant to section 672.56(1).
