DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 17th day of December 2018, the accused was found unfit to stand trial on account of a mental disorder on charges of assault, contrary to section 266 of the Criminal Code, assault with a weapon, contrary to section 267(a) of the Criminal Code, and three counts of uttering threats, contrary to section 264.1(1)(a) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently living in the community on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 10th day of May 2022 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the restriction of liberties was justified.
