DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on May 14th, 2015, the accused was found unfit to stand trial on a charge of assault, contrary to section 266 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital;
AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 15th day of
June, 2015, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.48 of the Criminal Code;
AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or
assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement
decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED that the accused be returned to court, the Board finding him fit to stand trial. He is to be detained in hospital pending such return to maintain fitness, with a ceiling of privilege of L2.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director of the Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to him under section 672.56(1) the authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberty of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits and subject to the conditions set out in this order.
