

IN THE MATTER OF the NOVA SCOTIA REVIEW BOARD

AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, MARCEL DAVID LAWRENCE

AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.47 of the Criminal Code

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 2nd day of May, 2018, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on charges of unlawful confinement, contrary to section 297(2) of the Criminal Code (2 counts); assault, contrary to section 266 of the Criminal Code; assaulting a peace officer, contrary to section 270(1)(a) (3 counts); resisting a peace officer, contrary to section 129(a) of the Criminal Code; and breach of probation, contrary to section 733.1 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently serving a sentence in the Central Nova Scotia Correctional Facility;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 9th day of July, 2018, to make an order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED that the accused be detained in hospital upon his release from the correctional facility, with a ceiling of privileges of L4.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Administrator of the East Coast Forensic Hospital, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this order. The Board delegates to him pursuant to section 672.56(1) the authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberties of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits set out in this disposition.
