AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, ALBERT IAN MacDONALD

AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.81(1) of the Criminal Code

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 5th day of November, 1996, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of manslaughter;

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently living in Breton Ability Centre in Cape Breton; **AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 1st day of October, 2018;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED that the conditional discharge previously granted to the accused be continued, on the following terms:

- 1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
- 2. Maintain good mental health;
- 3. Adhere to the recommendations of the Community Mental Health Team;
- 4. Comply with follow up by the Forensic Community Program;
- 5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;
- 6. Abstain from the use of alcohol and illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;
- 7. Reside in premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide by the rules and regulations of the residence;
- 8. Notify the Review Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change of address;
- 9. Appear before the Board when requested;
- 10. Remain within the province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing has been received from the Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. MacDonald is not to be placed at any facility below the level of an ARC, and that a review of this disposition will be immediately scheduled if his treatment with Clozapine should be discontinued.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Administrator of the East Coast Forensic Hospital, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this order.
