DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 12th day of January, 2018, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on charges of assault with a weapon, contrary to section 267(a) of the Criminal Code; dangerous operation of a motor vehicle, contrary to section 249(1)(a) of the Criminal Code; mischief, contrary to section 430(4) of the Criminal Code; failure to stop at an accident, contrary to section 252(1) of the Criminal Code; and breach of recognizance, contrary to section 811 of the Criminal Code (4 counts);

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently detained in hospital with a ceiling of privileges of L4;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 15th day of April, 2019, to make an order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be conditionally discharged, on the following terms:

- 1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
- 2. Maintain good mental health;
- 3. Adhere to the recommendations of the community mental health team;
- 4. Comply with follow up by the forensic community program;
- 5. Comply with conditions recommended by the forensic community program;
- 6. Abstain from the use of alcohol, cannabis and illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;

- 7. Reside in premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide by the rules and regulations of the residence;
- 8. Notify the Review Board and the Forensic Hospital of any change of address;
- 9. Appear before the Board when requested;
- 10. Remain within the province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing has been received from the Board;
- 11. Do not have any contact with Dr. Matthew Morgan or any member of his family.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Services, Capital District Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this order. The Board delegates to him under section 672.56(1) the authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberty of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits and subject to the conditions set out in this order.

This hearing will be treated as an annual hearing for the purposes of s. 672.
