AND WHEREAS on the 7th day of November, 2014, the accused was found *Not Criminally Responsible on account of a mental disorder* on charges of possession of a weapon, contrary to Section 88(1); robbery, contrary to Section 344; assault with a weapon (x's 4), contrary to Section 267(a) and use of imitation firearm (x's 3), contrary to Section 85(2)(a) of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital.

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made.
