DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on May 11th, 2018, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of uttering threats, contrary to section 264.1 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently detained in hospital;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 10th day of December, 2018, to make an order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED that the accused be detained in hospital, with a ceiling of privileges of L6.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Administrator of the East Coast Forensic Hospital, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this order. The Board delegates to him pursuant to section 672.56(1) the authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberties of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits set out in this disposition.
