DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 1st day of December 2008, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of aggravated assault, contrary to section 268 of the Criminal Code; a charge of possession of a weapon, contrary to section 88 of the Criminal Code; and a charge of breach of probation, contrary to section 733.1 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently residing in the community on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 20th day of June 2023 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

The Board finds that the restriction of liberties was justified.
