DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on October 29th, 2012, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on charges of uttering threats, contrary to section 264.1(1)(b) of the Criminal Code, and causing a disturbance, contrary to section 175(1)(a) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 17th day of November, 2015, adjourned from October 13th, 2015 to allow the Dept. of Community Services to be made a party, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 and 672.81(2.1) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED that the conditional discharge previously granted be continued, on the following terms:

- 1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
- 2. Maintain good mental health;
- 3. Adhere to the recommendations of the Community Mental Health Team;
- 4. Comply with follow up by the Forensic Community Program;
- 5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;
- 6. Abstain from the use of alcohol and illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;
- 7. Reside in premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide by the rules and regulations of the residence;
- 8. Notify the Review Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change of address;

- 9. Appear before the Board when requested;
- 10. Remain within the province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing has been received from the Board.

The Board finds that the hospital was justified in restricting the liberties of the accused.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Services, Capital District Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Administrator of the hospital may exercise his discretion upon such terms and conditions, as he deems appropriate.
