DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 9 th day of November, 2023, the accused was found Unfit to Stand Trial on charges of: Mischief contrary to s. 430(4) and on a charge of At Large on Undertaking Fail to Comply contrary to s. 145(4)(A) x11 and on a charge of At Large on Release Order Fail to Comply contrary to s. 145(5)(A) x4 and on a charge of Assault contrary to s. 266 x4 and on a charge of Uttering Threats contrary to s. 264.1(1)(A) and on a charge of Assault a Peace Officer contrary to s.270(1)(A) and on a charge of Assault with a Weapon contrary to s. 267(A) and on a charge of Theft Under \$5000.00 contrary to s. 334(b) of the Criminal Code of Canada.

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently detained at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital.

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 15th day of April 2024, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to s.672.54 of the Criminal Code of Canada.

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made.

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused is found fit to stand trial and is sent back to Court pursuant to s. 672.48(2) of the Criminal Code. The detention order is continued with no change pursuant to s. 672.49(1) of the Criminal Code.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
