AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to Section 672.47(1) (First Hearing) of the Criminal Code of Canada.

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 8 th day of January 2024, the accused was found Unfit to Stand Trail on charges of: Assault, contrary to s.266; and further on a charge of At Large on Undertaking fails to comply contrary to s.145(4)(a) x2; and further on a charge of At Large on Confirmed Undertaking contrary to s.145(4)(b) of the Criminal Code of Canada.

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently detained at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital.

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 11th day of March 2024 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to s.672.54 of the Criminal Code of Canada.

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made.

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be subject to a detention order with a ceiling level of L4; community access only to be in the presence of a person or persons approved by the Clinical Team at the East Coast Forensic Hospital.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the accused is arrested pursuant to section 672.91 of the Criminal Code for a breach or anticipated breach of the terms of this disposition, they may, under section 672.92(1)(b) of the Criminal Code, be delivered

to the East Coast Forensic Hospital, 88 Gloria McCluskey Avenue, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).

The Board also finds that the accused remains unfit to stand trial.
