## **DISPOSITION ORDER**

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently residing in the community.

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 22nd day of April, 2024 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to s.672.54 of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made.

IT IS ORDERED that the accused by discharged absolutely.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
