## **DISPOSITION ORDER**

WHEREAS on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of December, 1994, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of first degree murder;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is detained at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital with a ceiling of privileges of directly supervised passes into the community;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held at the hospital on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2016, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code, the request for the hearing having been made by the Crown;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment and assessment of an accused in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement order is made.

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused Allen Garnet Nickerson continue to be detained at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital with a ceiling of privileges of indirectly supervised community day passes, L4.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Administrator of the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to him pursuant to section 672.56(1) the authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberties of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits set out in this disposition.
