**DISPOSITION ORDER (Consent ROL)**

**WHEREAS** on the 10th day of September 2019, the accused was found not  
criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of assault with a  
weapon contrary to section 267(A) of the Criminal Code, occurring on May 21, 2019,  
in Dartmouth, Nova Scotia;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic  
Hospital with a Board granted ceiling level of privileges of L6;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held on the 25th day of September 2023 to make a  
Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody,  
treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order,  
disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** the restriction of liberties was justified.
