DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 24th day of October, 2017, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on charges of causing bodily harm to a peace officer, contrary to section 270.01 of the Criminal Code; assaulting a peace officer, contrary to section 270(1) of the Criminal Code; resisting a peace officer, contrary to section 129(a) of the Criminal Code; breach of probation, contrary to section 733.1 of the Criminal Code (two counts); and mischief, contrary to section 430(4) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained in hospital;


AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the hospital on the 4th day of December, 2017, to make an order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made:

IT IS ORDERED that the accused be detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital with a ceiling of privileges of L4.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Administrator of the East Coast Forensic Hospital, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this order. The Board delegates to him under section 672.56(1) the authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberty of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits and subject to the conditions set out in this order.
