IN THE MATTER OF the NOVA SCOTIA REVIEW BOARD AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, MATTHEW SEYMOUR AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held under section 672.82(1) of the Criminal Code

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 29th day of December, 2017, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on charges of break and enter, contrary to section 348(1)(b) of the Criminal Code; damage to property, contrary to section 430(4) of the Criminal Code; theft under \$5,000.00, contrary to section 334(b) of the Criminal Code; and possession of stolen property not exceeding \$5,000.00, contrary to section 355(b) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 15th day of October, 2018, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED that the accused be conditionally discharged, on the following terms:

- 1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
- 2. Maintain good mental health;
- 3. Adhere to the recommendations of the Community Mental Health Team;
- 4. Comply with follow up by the Forensic Community Program;
- 5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;
- 6. Abstain from the use of alcohol, cannabis and illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;

- 7. Reside in premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide by the rules and regulations of the residence;
- 8. Notify the Review Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change of address;
- . Appear before the Board when requested;
- 10. Remain within the province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing has been received from the Board.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Services, Capital District Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this order. The Board delegates to him pursuant to section 672.56(1) the authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberties of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits set out in this disposition.
