## DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on December 13<sup>th</sup>, 2017, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on charges of theft while armed with an offensive weapon, contrary to section 344(1)(b) of the Criminal Code; having his face concealed with intent to commit an indictable offence, contrary to section 351(2) of the Criminal Code; and possession of stolen property under \$5,000.00, contrary to section 354(1) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently detained in hospital;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 23rd day of January, 2018, to make an order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition order or placement decision is made.

IT IS ORDERED that the accused be detained in hospital, with a ceiling of privilege of L5.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to him authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberty of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits set out herein pursuant to section 672.56(1).
