DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 3rd day of February 2020, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of uttering threats, contrary to section 264.1(1)(a) of the Criminal Code, possession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose, contrary to section 88(1) of the Criminal Code, failure to attend, contrary to section 145(5)(a) of the Criminal Code and disobeying an order of the court, contrary to section 127(1) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently residing in the community on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;


AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 12th day of June 2023 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be discharged absolutely.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order.
