AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, STEPHEN ROBERT TAMLYN AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.81(1) of the Criminal Code of Canada.

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on February 23rd, 2017, the accused was found unfit to stand trial on a charge of assault causing bodily harm, contrary to section 267(b) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on May 22nd, 2018, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.48(1) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment, disposition or placement decision is made.

The Board finds that the accused is unfit to stand trial and orders that he be conditionally discharged, on the following terms:

- 1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
- 2. Maintain good mental health;
- 3. Adhere to the recommendations of the community mental health team;
- 4. Comply with follow up by the forensic community program;
- 5. Comply with conditions recommended by the forensic community program;
- 6. Abstain from the use of alcohol and illegal drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;
- 7. Notify the Board and the hospital of any change in address;
- 8. Appear before the Board when requested;
- 9. Remain within the province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing from the Board has been obtained.
- 10. Reside in premises approved by the hospital.

This conditional discharge is granted solely for the purposes of classification to allow a potential placement in the Quest Program. If transferred to Quest, any access to the community is to be supervised one on one. While detained in this hospital his privilege level is not to exceed L2.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Services, Capital District Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to the Director the authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberty of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits of this disposition pursuant to section 672.56(1).
