AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, STEPHEN ROBERT TAMLYN

AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.48(1) of the

Criminal Code of Canada.

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on February 23rd, 2017, the accused was found unfit to stand trial on a charge of assault causing bodily harm, contrary to section 267(b) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on May 8th, 2017, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.48 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment, disposition or placement decision is made.

The Board finds that the accused is unfit to stand trial and orders his continued detention with a ceiling of privilege of L2.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Services, Capital District Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to the Director the authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberty of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits of this disposition pursuant to section 672.56(1).
