### **DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of July 2020, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of assaulting a peace officer, contrary to s. 270(1)(a) of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is currently residing in the hospital with a Board ordered ceiling level of privileges of L5;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of November 2021 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

### **IT IS ORDERED THAT**

**The Board finds that the hospital was justified in restricting the liberties of Mr. Thiessen.**

**THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU**, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
