## DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 28<sup>th</sup> of October, 2016, the accused was found unfit to stand trial on charges of Assault, contrary to section 266 of the Criminal Code, unlawful confinement, contrary to section 279(2) of the Criminal Code, and overcoming resistance to the commission of an offence, contrary to section 246(A) of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is presently detained in hospital;

AND WHEREAS hearings were held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2016, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED that the accused be detained in hospital with a ceiling of L2, the Board having found him to be unfit to stand trial.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Services, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to him authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberty of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits set out herein pursuant to section 672.56(1).
