

**IN THE MATTER OF the NOVA SCOTIA REVIEW BOARD**  
**AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, MICHAEL WOLFE**  
**AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.82(1) of the Criminal Code**

**DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2014, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on three charges of breach of probation, contrary to section 733.1 of the Criminal Code, and one charge of break and enter, contrary to section 348(1)(b) of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is presently detained in hospital;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2015, to make an order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** the accused be discharged absolutely.

**THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU**, the Administrator of the East Coast Forensic Hospital, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this order.
