Preparation Of Terms Of Reference For Environmental Assessment Pursuant To The Nova Scotia Environment Act

On July 10, 2006, the Minister of Environment and Labour concluded the environmental assessment review of Nova Scotia Transportation and Public Works' Focus Report for the proposed Highway 113, Halifax Regional Municipality, Nova Scotia. The Minister decided that an Environmental Assessment Report is required in accordance with Part IV of the Environment Act.

The purpose of the proposed Highway 113 is to provide a more efficient means of travel for motorists between Highway 103 and Highway 102, that bypasses the Halifax Urban Core. It will also relieve congestion on the Hammonds Plains Road. The proposed 4-lane divided highway will go from Highway 103 near Exit 4 to Highway 102 near Exit 3.
